## Responsibilities

- Collaborate with Zone Leaders to assist in the management and coordination of designated areas or zones during the Santa Fe Indian Market.
- Aid in the proper set-up and organization of vendor spaces according to event guidelines.
- Assist vendors in addressing any issues or concerns that may arise during the event.
- Support the Zone Leaders and SWAIA staff in managing crowd flow and ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for all participants.
- Provide information and guidance to visitors, answering inquiries about the event, vendors, and schedule.
- Assist with logistical tasks and any other duties assigned by the Zone Leaders or SWAIA staff.

### Requirements

- Availability for the entire duration of the Santa Fe Indian Market (August 11th, and August 14th to the 21st).
- Flexibility to work for extended periods of time.
- Must be reliable, punctual, and able to adapt to changing circumstances.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to work well in a team and follow instructions from Zone Leaders.
- Enthusiasm for Native American arts and culture.
- Willingness to provide excellent customer service to vendors and visitors.
